Overview: The NRA FIRST Steps Pistol Orientation is approximately 4 hours in length and is divided in two parts: Classroom and live fire. Completion of this orientation class satisfies the "Proof of Proficiency" required for a Concealed Weapon Permit application. Classroom Session: NRA FIRST Steps Pistol is designed to provide a hands-on introduction to the safe handling and proper orientation to one specific pistol action type for classes of four or fewer students. This 4-hour course, which includes classroom and range time, teaches students how to shoot a specific pistol action type. Students will learn the NRA's rules for safe gun handling; the particular pistol model parts and operation; ammunition; shooting fundamentals; cleaning the pistol; and continued opportunities for skill development. Students will receive the Basics of Pistol Shooting handbook, NRA Gun Safety Rules brochure, Winchester/NRA Marksmanship Qualification booklet, FIRST Steps Course completion certificate

<u>Live Fire</u>: Following the classroom session, we will travel approximately 7 miles to Sharpshooters Indoor Range in Lorton, VA. The range session provides clients the opportunity to demonstrate safe shooting fundamentals.

<u>Course Design</u>: We limit the class size to 4 clients in order to maximize mentor-client engagement.

<u>Cost</u>: \$70.00. This fee covers classroom instruction, light refreshments, student books, range fees, gun rental, ammunition, safety equipment, and course completion certificate.

<u>Pre-Requisites and Required Materials</u>: Clients are only required to bring a great attitude and desire to learn. We will provide all materials.
